

FORT ZUMWALT SOUTH HIGH SCHOOL DANCE EXPECTATIONS

Three highlights of attending Fort Zumwalt South High School are the Homecoming Dance, Winter Formal, and Prom. Fort Zumwalt South High School proudly offers these dances for students' enjoyment. It is our expectation that students abide by the following dance expectations.

These are formal dances, and we trust our students to dress and act with respect and dignity. Dresses that expose excessive cleavage or midriff, have slits extending above mid-thigh, or are otherwise immodest will not be allowed. Likewise, men's shirts must remain buttoned and dress pants or khakis worn. Jeans and ball caps are not acceptable apparel. Students who arrive at the dance dressed inappropriately will not be admitted. Students who alter their dress after entering the dance will be escorted out. No warnings will be given. Suggested apparel for the dance is as follows:

Suggested apparel for Men:

- Slacks, dress shirts (must be worn at all times), suits, ties or tuxedos

Suggested apparel for Ladies:

- Formal short or long dresses
- Dresses should be tasteful and meet policy requirements

Please refrain from wearing:

- Jeans, hats (baseball caps), shorts

Please refrain from wearing:

- Jeans, shorts, bare-midriff apparel, see through dresses, etc.

If you are unsure about the appropriateness of a certain dress or outfit, please contact the student's grade level assistant principal. He or she will be glad to offer advice. When in doubt, it is advised that a more conservative form of attire be selected.

Students are expected to behave appropriately on and off the dance floor. Therefore, sexually explicit dancing is not allowed. No warnings will be given. These guidelines should serve as notice and will also be explained to students in discipline reviews. Students who engage in this type of dancing will be immediately escorted from the dance, with no refund.

The following regulations will continue to be enforced at Fort Zumwalt South High School dances:

1. Students must show a student identification badge for admission.
2. Approved guests must show a drivers license or photo identification and an approved guest pass/ticket. Middle school students and people 21 years of age and older are not eligible to attend these events as guests.
3. Fort Zumwalt students are responsible for both their own behavior and demeanor and that of their guests.
4. Students may not leave and reenter the dance.
5. Sexually explicit dancing or inappropriate dancing that may result in disruption or injury (i.e. slamming, moshing, etc.) is prohibited.
6. Fort Zumwalt South High School students and guests are expected to dress appropriately for the dance.
7. Any person removed from the dance by Fort Zumwalt South High School staff is not entitled to a refund.
8. All other school rules apply as they do at any school function.

I understand and agree that, as a condition of purchasing tickets and attending formal dances at Fort Zumwalt South High School, I will abide by the above expectations for dress and behavior. I understand the consequences for not doing so, and I will accept the decisions of the administration as they interpret these expectations.
